



Spiral Bottle Cover

This bottle cover is super fast and easy to make and is just the thing to keep your hands and fingers from getting to cold when holding a water bottle.

Materials Needed

Worsted weight acrylic yarn in white
Size H/8 or 5mm aluminum crochet hook
Yarn needle for weaving in ends

Yarn Thickness: 4mm

Gauge: 4dc = 1"

Finished Size: 7" tall

Skill Level: Beginner

Instructions

RND 1: Ch6. Join w/slst to first ch to form ring. Ch4. Sc in ring, ch4, 4 times. Join w/slst to first ch of ch 4.

RND 2: Slst into the first ch3 sp. Ch3, 2dc in same sp. Ch3. *3dc in next ch3 sp. Ch3. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 3: Slst into the next dc. Ch3. Dc in next dc. Dc in next ch3 sp. Ch5. Sk next dc. *Dc in each of

the next 2 dc. Dc in next ch3 sp. Ch5. Sk next dc. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 4-11: Slst into the next dc. Ch3. Dc in next dc. Dc in next ch5 sp. Ch5. Sk next dc. *Dc in each of the next 2 dc. Dc in next ch5 sp. Ch5. Sk next dc. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3. Fasten off and weave ends into back of work.



Finishing Tie: Ch60. Trim ends to 1/2". Weave through round 11 and tie into a bow to secure onto bottle.
