

## Net Stitch Toy Bag

This toy bag is just the right size for carrying around a few small toys in the car. Or your child could put a small collection of action figures into it.

## Materials Needed

Worsted weight acrylic yarn in white Size H/8 or 5mm aluminum crochet hook Yarn needle for weaving in ends

Yarn Thickness: 4mm

Gauge: 4dc = 1"

**Finished Size:** 7"x10" **Skill Level:** Beginner



## **Instructions**

**RND 1:** Ch5. Join w/slst to first ch to form ring. Ch3. 11dc in ring. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

**RND 2:** Ch3. Dc in same st as slst. 2dc in each dc around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

**RND 3:** Ch3. Dc in same st as slst. Dc in next dc. \*2dc in next dc. Dc in next dc. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

**RND 4:** Ch5, sk 2 sts, sc in next st, 11 times. Ch2. Dc in first ch of the first ch5.

**RND 5-15:** Ch5, sc in next ch5 sp, 11 times. Ch2. Dc in top of next dc to join.

**RND 16:** Ch1. Sc in same sp as last st. Ch3. \*3sc in next ch5 sp, ch3. Rep from \* around. Sc in next ch5 sp. Join w/slst to ch1. Fasten off and weave ends into back of work.

**Finishing Drawstrings.:** Make 2. Ch71. Fasten off. Weave through ch3 sps of round 16 in opposite directions. Tie ends together with a square knot. Then trim ends to within a ½" of the knot.

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
