



# Braid Stitch Coaster

This coaster uses this the special stitch, the [braid stitch](#), and is fun and fast to make. This is an example of what an even number of stitches across looks like.

## Materials Needed:

Small amount Dawn Sayelle Worsted weight yarn. Country Blue  
Size G wooden hook or Aluminum hook.  
Yarn Needle

**Gauge:** 4dc=1"

**Yarn Thickness:** 4mm

**Finished Size:** 4"x4"

**Skill Level:** Beginner

## Instructions

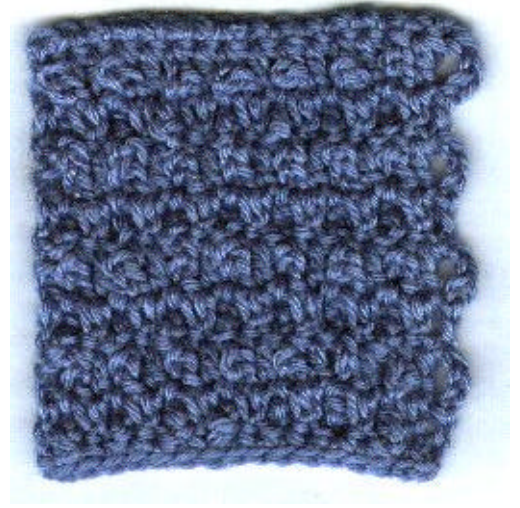
**ROW 1:** Ch17. Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch3, turn.

**ROW 2:** Brd in next sc. \*Dc in next sc. Brd in next sc. Rep from \* across. You will end with a brd in top of ch3. Ch3, turn.

**ROW 3:** \*Brd in brd. Dc in dc. Rep from \* across. End with a dc in top of ch3. Ch3, turn.

**ROW 4-9:** Rep row 3. At the end of row 9, ch1 turn.

**ROW 10:** Sc in each st across. Fasten off weave ends into back of work.
