



Honey Flower Motif

This motif is fast and easy to make and would look wonderful in a rainbow of colors in any afghan. Here is an idea. Get the 6 colors of the rainbow and a skein of white yarn. Make a bunch of these with white in the center and the colors on the last round. Then sew or crochet them together with the white yarn. I think this would be breathtaking.

Materials Needed

For 1 motif

Small amount white worsted weight acrylic yarn.

Small amount desired color worsted weight acrylic yarn.

Size H/8 or 5mm aluminum crochet hook.

Yarn needle for weaving in ends.

Yarn Thickness: 4mm

Gauge: 4dc=1"

Finished Size: 5½" x 5"

Skill Level: Beginner

Instructions

With White.

RND 1: Ch5. Join w/slst to first ch to form ring. Ch3. Dc in ring. Ch2. *2dc in ring. Ch2. Rep from * 4 times more. Join w/slst to top of ch3. You should now have 6 ch2 spaces around.

RND 2: Ch3. Dc in next dc. Dc, ch5, dc in next ch2 sp. *Dc in each of the next 2 dc. Dc, ch5, dc in next

ch2 sp. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 3: Ch1. Sc in next dc. Sk next dc. 8dc in next ch5 sp. Sk next dc. *Sc in each of the next 2 dc. Sk next dc. 8dc in next ch5 sp. Sk next dc. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to ch1. Fasten off white.

RND 4: Join desired color in same st as slst. Ch3. Dc in next sc. Hdc in

each of the next 2 dc. Sc in each of the next 2 dc. Ch2. Sc in each of the next 2 dc. Hdc in each of the next 2 dc. *Dc in each of the next 2 sc. Hdc in each of the next 2 dc. Sc in each of the next 2 dc. Ch2. Sc in each of the next 2 dc. Hdc in each of the next 2 dc. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3. Fasten off and weave ends into back of work.
