



# Scrappers Hexagon Motif

You could make a scrap savers afghan with this motif. It would also make a wonderful take along project. What a great way to use up all those little scraps you have stashed!

## Materials Needed

Worsted weight acrylic yarn in bright pink  
Worsted weight acrylic yarn in light blue  
Worsted weight acrylic yarn in pale yellow  
Size H/8 or 5mm aluminum crochet hook  
Yarn needle for weaving in ends

**Yarn Thickness:** 4mm

**Gauge:** 4dc = 1"

**Finished Size:** 4½" diam

**Skill Level:** Beginner



## Instructions

**RND 1:** With Blue. Ch6. Join w/slst to first ch to form ring. Ch1. 11sc in ring. Join w/slst to ch1.

**RND 2:** Ch3. Dc in next sc. Ch3. \*Dc in each of the next 2 sc. Ch3. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to top of ch3. Fasten off blue.

**RND 3:** Join Yellow to same st as slst. Ch1. Sc in next dc. (2sc, ch2,

2sc in next ch3 sp.) \*Sc in each of the next 2dc. Rep bet () once. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to ch1.

**RND 4:** Ch3. Dc in each of the next 2 sc. (Ch1. Dc, ch2, dc in next ch2 sp. Ch1. Sk next sc. Dc in next dc.) \*Dc in each of the next 3sc. Rep bet () once. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to top of ch3. Fasten off yellow.

**RND 5:** Join pink in same st as slst. Ch1. Sc in each of the next 2dc. (Sc in next ch1 sp. Sc in next dc. Sc, ch2, sc in next ch2 sp. Sc in next dc. Sc in next ch1 sp. Sc in next dc.) \*Sc in each of the next 3dc. Rep bet () once. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to ch1. Fasten off and weave all ends into back of work.
