



Wild Daisy Hexagon Motif

This hexagon is fast and easy to make and would look great made into an afghan of many different colors.

Materials Needed

Worsted weight acrylic yarn in bright yellow
Worsted weight acrylic yarn in white
Worsted weight acrylic yarn in green.
Size H/8 or 5mm aluminum crochet hook
Yarn needle for weaving in ends.

Yarn Thickness: 4mm

Gauge: 4dc = 1"

Finished Size: 6" diam

Skill Level: Beginner



Instructions

RND 1: With bright yellow. Ch6.

Join w/slst to first ch to form ring.

Ch3, 17 dc in ring. Join w/slst to top of ch3. Fasten off yellow.

RND 2: Join white in same st a slst.

Sc in same st. Ch9. *Sc in next st.

Ch9. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to first sc. Fasten off white.

RND 3: Join green in any ch9 lp. Sc in same lp. Ch2. *Sc in next ch9 lp.

Ch2. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to first sc.

RND 4: Slst into the first ch2 sp.

Ch3, dc, ch2, 2dc in same sp. 2dc in each of the next 2 ch2 sps. *2dc,

ch2, 2dc in next ch2 sp. 2dc in each of the next 2 ch2 sps. Rep from *

around. Join w/slst to top of ch3. Fasten off and weave all ends into back of work.
