



Honeycomb Dishcloth

This dishcloth uses the variation of the popcorn stitch the kernel stitch and since this dishcloth is round, I could not think of a better name. Sort of resembles the cereal of the same name. Well sort of. It is a fairly fast and easy dishcloth to make and would make a great addition to a gift basket of kitchen related goodies.

Materials Needed

1 2.5oz or 70.9 g ball Peaches & Creme Worsted weight cotton yarn. will make 2. Color. 3 cream.

Size G/6 or 4.25mm aluminum crochet hook

Yarn needle

Yarn Thickness: 2mm

Gauge: RND 1 is 1¾" diameter

Finished Size: 9" diameter

Skill Level: Beginner



Kernel Stitch (kst): 3dc in space indicated, take hook out of loop, insert in first dc made. then pick up dropped loop and pull through first dc. Ch1.

Instructions

RND 1: Ch4, join w/slst to first ch to form ring. Ch3, dc in ring. Ch3. *2dc in ring. Ch3. Rep from * 4 times more. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 2: Ch3. Dc in next dc. Kst, ch2, kst in next ch3 sp. *Dc in each of the next 2 dc. Kst, ch2, kst in next ch3 sp. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 3: Ch3, dc in same st as slst. 2dc in next dc. Kst, ch2, kst in next

ch2 sp. *2dc in each of the next 2 dc. Kst, ch2, kst in next ch2 sp. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 4: Ch3, dc in next dc. Ch3. Dc in next 2 dc. Kst, ch2, kst in next ch2 sp. *Dc in each of the next 2 dc. Ch3. Dc in each of the next 2 dc. Kst, ch2, kst in next ch2 sp. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 5: Ch3, dc in same st as slst. 2dc in next dc. Kst, ch2, kst in next ch3 sp. 2dc in each of the next 2 dc. Kst, ch2, kst in next ch2 sp. *2dc in each of the next 2 dc. Kst, ch2, kst in next ch3 sp. 2dc in each of the next 2 dc. Kst, ch2, kst in

next ch2 sp. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 6: Ch3. Dc in each of the next 3 dc. Kst, ch2, kst in next ch2 sp. Dc in each of the next 4 dc. Kst, ch2, kst in next ch2 sp. *Dc in each of the next 4dc. Kst, ch2, kst in next ch2 sp. Dc in each of the next 4 dc. Kst, ch2, kst in next ch2 sp. Rep from * around. join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 7: Ch1. Sc in each of the next 3 dc. Work 7dc in next ch2 sp. *Sc in each of the next 4 dc. Work 7dc in next ch2 sp. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to ch1. Fasten off and weave ends into back of work.
