



# Dish Scrubby Pad

Designed by Julie A. Bolduc

This is more of a scrubbing cloth than a little scrubby. It is bigger than a scrubby and smaller than a dishcloth. It has great scrubbing power due to the fact it is made with the same nylon yarn that I use for all of my scrubby patterns.

## Materials Needed:

Needloft nylon Plastic Canvas Yarn in desired color.

Size H 5mm aluminum crochet hook

Yarn needle

**Gauge:** 4dc=1"

**Yarn Thickness** 4mm

**Finished Size:** =4"x6"

**Skill Level:** Easy



## Instructions

**ROW 1:** Ch 24. Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch3, turn.

**ROW 2:** Fpd in 2nd dc. \*Dc in next dc. Fpd in next dc. Rep from \* across. End with a dc in top of ch3. Ch3, turn.

**ROW 3-10:** Fpd in fpd. \*Dc in next dc. Fpd in fpd. Rep from \* across. Dc in top of ch3. Ch3, turn. But at the end of ROW 10, ch1 and do not fasten off. Work a round of sc around perimeter working 3 sc in each corner. Join w/slst to first sc.
