

Midget Dishcloth

This smaller than average dishcloth is very fast and easy to make. You could also use this pattern with worsted weight varn for a bigger afghan square. Just use a size H aluminum hook and worsted weight acrylic yarn.

Materials Needed

Speed Cro Sheen in Ecru Size 0 steel crochet hook Tapestry Needle for weaving in ends

Yarn Thickness 2mm **Gauge:** 6dc =1" **Finished Size:** 7"x7" Skill Level: Beginner

Instructions

RND 1: Ch6. Join w/slst to first ch to form ring. Ch1, sc in ring. Ch2. *2sc in ring. Ch2. Rep from * two times more. Join w/slst to ch1.

RND 2: Ch3. Dc in next sc. 2dc, ch2, 2dc in next ch2 sp. *Dc in each of the next 2 sc. 2dc, ch2, 2dc in next ch2 corner sp. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 3: Ch1. Sc in next dc. Ch2. Sk next 2 dc. 2dc, ch2, 2dc in next ch2 corner sp. Ch2. Sk next 2 dc. *Sc in each of the next 2 dc. Ch2. Sk next 2 dc. 2dc, ch2, 2dc in next ch2 corner sp. Ch2. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to ch1.

RND 4: Ch3. Dc in next sc. 2dc in next ch2 sp. Ch2. Sk next 2dc. 2dc, ch2, 2dc in next ch2 corner sp. Ch2. Sk next 2 dc. Dc in next ch2 sp. *Dc in each of the next 2 sc. 2dc in next ch2 sp. Ch2. Sk next 2dc. 2dc, ch2, 2dc in next ch2 corner sp. Ch2. Sk next ch2 sp. 2dc in next ch2 sp. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 5: Slst in next 2dc. Ch3. Dc in next dc. 2dc in next ch2 sp. Ch2. Sk next 2 dc. 2dc, ch2, 2dc in next ch2 corner sp. Ch2. Sk next 2 dc. 2dc in next ch2 sp. Dc in each of the next 2 dc. Ch 2. *Sk next 2 dc. Dc in each of the next 2dc. 2dc in next ch2 sp. Ch2. Sk next 2 dc. 2dc, ch2, 2dc in next **RND 9:** Ch3. Dc in each of the next 2sc. ch2 corner sp. Ch2. Sk next 2 dc. 2dc in next ch2 sp. Dc in each of the next 2 dc. Ch2. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 6: (Ch4. Sk next 2dc. Sc in next dc. Ch4. Sc in next dc. Ch4. Sc in next ch2 corner sp. Ch4. Sk next dc. Sc in next dc. Ch4. Sc in next dc. ch4. Sk next 2dc. Sc in next dc. Ch4.) *Sc in next dc. Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to first ch of the first ch4.

RND 7: Slst in each of the first 2 chs of the first ch4. Ch4. *Sc in next ch4 sp. Ch4. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to first ch of the first ch4.

RND 8: Slst into the first ch4 sp. 2sc in same sp. Ch1. 3sc in next ch4 sp. Ch1. 3dc, ch2, 3dc in next ch4 corner sp. Ch1. (3sc in



next ch4 sp. Ch1. four times). *3sc in next ch4 sp. Ch1. 3sc in next ch4 sp. Ch1. 3dc, ch2, 3dc in next ch4 corner sp. Ch1. (3sc in next ch4 sp. Ch1. four times.) Rep from * around. Join w/slst to ch1.

Dc in next ch1 sp. Dc in each of the next 3 sc. Dc in next ch1 sp. Dc in each of the next 3 dc. 2dc, ch2, 2dc in next ch2 corner sp. Dc in each of the next 3dc. Dc in next ch1 sp. RND 10: Ch1. Sc in each of the next 12dc. Sc, ch2, sc in next ch2 corner sp. Sc in each of the next 22 dc. *Sc in each of the next 13 dc. Sc, ch2, sc in next ch2 corner sp. Sc in each of the next 22dc. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to ch1. Fasten off. weave ends into back of work

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
