This doily is designed with the bride in mind. It would make a great package topper for a wedding gift. She could then use it in her decor in her home.

Materials Needed

Small amount white crochet cotton size 10. Southmaid was used in the example. Size 8 steel crochet hook Boye was used in the example. Tapestry needle

Thread Size: 10thread Gauge: 10 sc=1" Finished Size: 7" diameter Skill Level: Beginner

Instructions

RND 1: Ch12, join w/sls to first ch to form ring. Ch1. Work 16 sc in ring. Join w/slst to first sc.

RND 2: Ch3. Dc in same st as slst. Ch4. Sk next sc. *2dc in next sc. Ch4. Sk next sc. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 3: Ch3, dc in next dc. Ch2. Dc, ch4, dc in next ch4 sp. Ch2. *Dc in each of the next 2 dc. Dc, ch4, dc in next ch4 sp. Ch2. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 4: Slst in the next dc and in each of the next 5 sts. Sc in ch4 lp. Ch9. *Sc in next ch4 lp. Ch9. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to first sc.


RND 5: Ch1. Sc in each of the next 4 chs. *Ch4. Sk next ch. Sc in each of the next 9 sts. Rep from * 7 times more. Ch4. Sk next ch. Sc in each of last4 sts. Join w/sls to ch1.

RND 6: Ch6. Dc in same st as slst. Ch3. Sk next 4 sc. 9dc in next ch4 sp. Ch3. Sk next 4sc. *Dc, ch3, dc in next sc. Ch3. Sk next 4 sc. 9dc in next ch4 sp. Ch3. Sk next 4sc. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to 3rd ch of ch6.

RND 7: Ch6. Dc in next dc. Ch3. Dc in **RND 10:** Ch6. Dc in next dc. Ch9. Sk next dc. Ch1. Sk next dc. Dc in next dc. the next 4dc. Sc in next ch2 sp. Ch9. Ch1. Sk next dc. Dc, ch3, dc in next dc. RND 9: Ch6. Dc in next dc, ch1, four times. Dc, ch3, dc in next ch3 sp. Ch1, dc in next dc, three times. Ch1. *Dc in next dc. Ch3. Dc in next dc, ch1, three times. Dc, ch3, dc in next ch3 sp. Ch1, dc in next dc, four times. Ch1. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to 3rd ch of ch 6.



Dc in next dc. Ch9. Sk the next 4dc. Sc in next ch2 sp. Ch9. Sk the next 4 dc. Rep from * around. Join w/sls to 3rd ch

RND 11: Ch1. *Sc in each of the next 3 chs. Sc in next dc. Sc in each of the next 4chs. Ch4. Sk next ch Sc in each of the next 4 chs. Sc in next sc. Sc in next 4 chs. Ch4. Sk next ch. Sc in each from * around but join w/slst to ch1 when you get back to where you started this round.
