



Stranded Webs Doily

This doily is small but fun to make. It sort of looks like 2 spider webs stranded together, hence the name. My daughter came up with the idea of the name. It can also be used as a motif in a tablecloth or a set of placemats.

Materials Needed

Size 10 Crochet Cotton in white.

Size 7 steel crochet hook

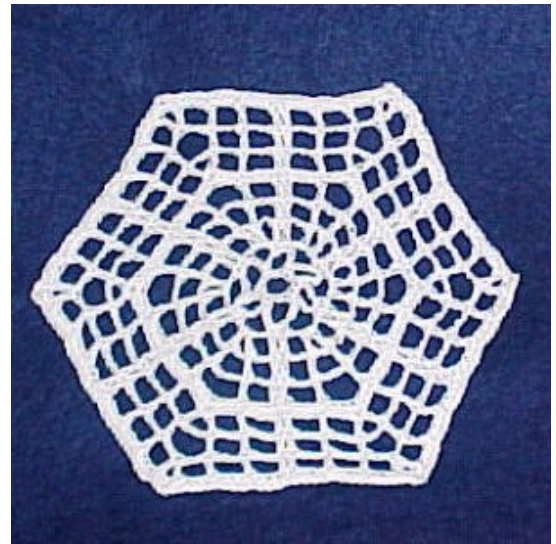
Tapestry Needle for weaving in ends

Yarn Thickness: 10thread

Gauge: 10sc = 1"

Finished Size: 4½" diam

Skill Level: Beginner



Instructions

RND 1: Ch12. Join w/slst to first ch to form ring. Ch1. Sc in first ch. Ch6. Sk 1 ch. *Sc in next ch. Ch1. Sk 1 ch. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to first sc.

RND 2: Slst in each of the next 2 chs. 2Sc in ch6 sp. Ch4. *2sc in next ch6 sp. Ch4. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to first sc.

RND 3: Ch3. Dc in next sc. Ch3. Dc, ch2, dc in next ch4 sp. Ch3. *Dc in each of the next 2 sc. Ch3. Dc, ch2, dc in next ch4 sp. Ch3. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 4: Ch3. Dc in next dc. (Ch3. Dc in next dc. Ch4. Dc in next dc. Ch3.) *Dc in each of the next 2dc. Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 5: Ch3. Dc in next dc. (Ch3. Dc in next dc. Ch5. Dc in next dc. Ch3.) *Dc in each of the next 2dc. Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 6: Ch1. Sc in next dc. (Sc in each of the next 3 chs. Sc in next dc. Sc in each of the next 2 chs. Sc, ch2, sc in next ch. Sc in each of the next 2 chs. Sc in next dc. Sc in each of the next 3 chs.) *Sc in each of the next 2 dc. rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to ch1.

RND 7: Ch3. Dc in next sc. (Ch3. Sk 3sc. Dc in next dc. Ch3. Dc, ch3, dc in next ch2 sp. Ch3. Sk 3sc. Dc in next sc. Ch3. Sk 3sc.) *Dc in each of the next 2sc. Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 8: Ch3. Dc in next dc. (Ch3. Dc in next dc. Ch3. Dc in next dc.

Ch5. Dc in next dc. Ch3. Dc in next dc. Ch3.) *Dc in each of the next 2 dc. Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 9: Ch3. Dc in next dc. (Ch3. Dc in next dc. Ch3. Dc in next dc. Ch3. Dc, ch2, dc in 3rd ch of ch5. Ch3. Dc in next dc. Ch3. Dc in next dc. Ch3.) *Dc in each of the next 2 dc. Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 10: Ch1. Sc in next dc. (Sc in each of the next 3 chs, sc in next dc, three times. Sc in next ch. Ch2. Sc in next ch. Sc in next dc. Sc in each of the next 3 chs. Sc in next dc. Sc in each of the next 3 chs.) *Sc in each of the next 2 dc. Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to ch1. Fasten off and weave all ends into back of work.
