

Lacet Filet Square Doily

This doily is fairly fast and easy to make and uses lacets and filets and done in the round.

Materials Needed

Size 10 crochet cotton in cream. Southmaid was used in the example Size 7 steel crochet hook Tapestry Needle for weaving in ends

Yarn Thickness: 10thread Gauge: 8sc=1" Finished Size: 8"x8" Skill Level: Intermediate

Instructions

RND 1: Ch12. Join w/slst to first ch to form ring. Ch1. 15sc in ring. Join w/slst to ch1.

RND 2: Ch1, sc in same st as slst. (Ch4, dc in 4th ch from hook. Sk next sc.) *Sc in next sc. Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to first sc.

RND 3: Ch5. (Dc, ch2, dc in next ch4 sp. Ch5. Dc, ch2, dc in next ch4 sp. Ch2.) *Dc in next sc. Ch2. Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to 3rd ch of ch5.


RND 4: Ch5. (Dc in next dc, ch2, twice. Dc, ch5, dc in 3rd ch of the next ch5 corner sp. Ch2, dc in next dc, twice. Ch2.) *Dc in next dc. Ch2. Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to 3rd ch of ch5.

RND 5: Ch3. (Dc in next dc. Ch3. Sc in next dc. Ch3. Dc in next dc. Ch2. Dc, ch2, dc in 3rd ch of the next ch5 corner sp. Ch2. Dc in next dc. Ch3. Sc in next dc. Ch3. Dc in next dc. Ch3. *Sc in next dc. Ch3. Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to first ch of ch3. **RND 6:** Slst in each of the next 2 chs and into the next dc. Ch9. (Dc in next dc. Ch2. Dc in next dc. Ch2. Dc, ch5, dc in 3rd ch of the next ch5 corner sp. Ch2. Dc in next dc. Ch2. Dc in next dc. Ch6. Dc in next dc. Ch6.) *Dc in next dc. Ch6. Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to 3rd ch of ch9.

RND 7: Ch5. (Sc in next ch6 sp. Ch2, dc in next dc, 3 times. Ch2. Dc, ch5, dc in 3rd ch of the next ch5 corner sp. Ch2, dc in next dc, 3 times. Sc in next ch6 sp. Ch2. Dc in next dc. Ch2. Sc in next ch6 sp. Ch2.) *Dc in next dc. Ch2. Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to 3rd ch of ch5.

RND 8: Ch5. (Dc in next sc. Ch2, dc in next dc, 4 times. Ch2. Dc, ch5, dc in 3rd ch of the next ch5 corner sp. Ch2, dc in next dc, 4 times. Ch2. Dc in next sc. Ch2. Dc in next dc. Ch2. Dc in next sc. Ch2.) *Dc in next dc. Ch2. Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to 3rd ch of ch5.

RND 9: Ch3. (2dc in next ch2 sp, dc in next dc, 6 times. 3dc, ch2, 3dc in next ch5 corner sp. Dc in next dc, 2dc in next ch2 sp, 8 times.) *Dc in next dc.



Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 10: Ch1. Sc in same st as slst. (Ch4, dc in 4th ch from hook, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc, 7 times. Ch4, dc in 4th ch from hook. Sc in next dc, ch4, dc in 4th ch from hook, sk 2 dc, 9 times.) *Sc in next dc. Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to first sc.

RND 11: Slst into the next ch4 sp. Ch5. (Dc in next ch4 sp, ch2, 6 times. Dc, ch5, dc in next ch4 sp in the corner. Ch2, dc in next ch4 sp, 9 times. Ch2.) *Dc in next ch4 sp. Ch2. Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to 3rd ch of ch5.

RND 12: Slst in the next ch. Sc in ch2 sp. ([Dc, ch2, dc, ch3, dc, ch2, dc in next ch2 sp. Sc in next ch2 sp.] Rep bet [] 2 times more. Dc, ch2, dc, ch2, dc, ch5, dc, ch2, dc, ch2, dc in ch5 corner sp. [[Sc in next ch2 sp. Dc, ch2, dc, ch3, dc, ch2, dc in next ch2 sp.]] Rep bet [[]] 4 times more.) *Sc in next ch2 sp. Rep bet () once. Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to first sc. Fasten off and weave ends into back of work.

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
