



# Summer Wreath Fridgie

This simple little wreath would make a great package topper for a birthday, Christmas or any other occasion gift. You could make it any color you would want for any occasion. It works up really quick.

## Materials Needed:

Small amount Southmaid8 or DMC 8 Crochet Cotton Lavender  
Size B (2.25mm) aluminum Crochet hook  
2" wide bone ring  
16" length of 3/16" wide picot edged satin ribbon.  
Small yarn needle

**Yarn Thickness:** 8thread

**Gauge:** 7sc = 1"

**Finished Size:** =3" diameter

**Skill Level:** Easy

## Instructions

**RND 1:** Tie yarn onto ring and work 44 sc in ring. Join w/slst to first sc.

**RND 2:** Ch1, dc in same st as slst. Ch3. \*Sk next st. Work the foll in the next st. (sc, dc, ch3.) Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to ch1. Fasten off and weave ends into back of work. Thread ribbon around first sc and dc sts and tie into a bow. Glue magnet to back.
