



# Daisy Square

This square may be similar to some you may have seen but this is my version. It has a big daisy in the center surrounded by two rounds of dc groups.

## Materials Needed:

- Small amount each white, yellow and spring green worsted weight yarn. Red Heart was used in the example.
- Size H/8 or 5mm aluminum Crochet hook
- Yarn needle

**Yarn Thickness:** 4mm

**Gauge:** 4dc=1"

**Finished Size:** 6" x 6"

**Skill Level:** Easy

## Instructions

**RND 1:** With Yellow, Ch 4, join with slst to first ch to form ring. Ch 1, wk 8 sc in ring. Join with a slst to first sc. Fasten off yellow.

**RND 2:** With white. Tie yarn onto first sc, ch 10, \*sc in same sc, ch 10 sc in next sc, ch 10. Repeat from \* around. You should now have sixteen ch10 lps. Slst to first ch of

first ch10 lp. Fasten off White.

**RND 3:** With green. Tie yarn on one of the ch10 lps at the top. Ch 3. \*sc in next ch 10 lp. Ch3, Rep from \* around. Join with a slst to first sc.

**RND 4:** Sl st into first ch3 sp. Ch3, 2dc, ch2, 3dc in same ch3sp. 3dc in next three-ch3 sps. \*3dc, ch2, 3dc in next

ch3 sp. 3dc in next three-ch3 sps. Repeat from \* around. Join with a slst to top of ch3.

**RND 5:** Sl st into first ch3 sp. Ch3, 2dc, ch2, 3dc in same ch3sp. 3dc in next four sps bet dc groups. \*3dc, ch2, 3dc in next ch3 sp. 3dc in next four sps bet dc groups. Repeat from \* around. Join with a slst to top of ch3. Fasten off and weave ends into work.
