



Wyman Square

Another town in Maine is what this square is named after. In fact, this is the town where my husband lived when we first started dating in 1983. This square is really fast and easy to make and would make a great addition to a friendship exchange afghan.

Materials Needed

Small amount worsted weight acrylic yarn
Size H/8 5mm aluminum crochet hook
Yarn Needle

Yarn Thickness: 4mm

Gauge: 4sc=1"

Finished Size: 6" x 6"

Skill Level: Beginner



Instructions

RND 1: Ch4, join w/slst to first ch to form ring. Ch3. 2dc in ring. Ch2. *3dc in ring. Ch2. Rep from * 2 times more. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 2: Ch1. Sc in each of the next 2 dc. 2sc, ch2, 2sc in next ch2 corner sp. *Sc in each of the next 3 dc. 2sc, ch2, 2sc in next ch2 corner sp. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to ch1.

RND 3: Ch3. Dc in each of the next 2 sc. Ch1. 3dc, ch2, 3dc in next ch2 corner sp. Ch1. Sk next 2 sc. *Dc in each of the next 3 sc. Ch1. 3dc, ch2, 3dc in next ch2 corner sp. Ch1. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 4: Ch1. Sc in each of the next 2 dc. Sc in next ch1 sp. Sc in each of the next 3 dc. 2sc, ch2, 2sc in next ch2 corner sp. Sc in each of the next 3 dc. Sc in next ch1 sp. *Sc in each of the next 3 dc. Sc in next ch1 sp. Sc in each of the next 3 dc. 2sc, ch2, 2sc in next ch2 corner sp. Sc in next ch1 sp. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to ch1.

RND 5: Ch3. Dc in each of the next 2 sc. Ch1. Sk next sc. Dc in each of the next 3 sc. Ch1. Sk next 2 sc. 3dc, ch2, 3dc in next ch2 corner sp. Ch1. Sk next 2 sc. Dc in each of the next 3 dc.
