



# Half Basic Granny Square Motif

A member made me realize I hadn't designed any half granny squares or hexagons so here is a first of a few designs I have planned for the future. You can add 1 more row to make this work with the standard 6" granny square.

## Materials Needed

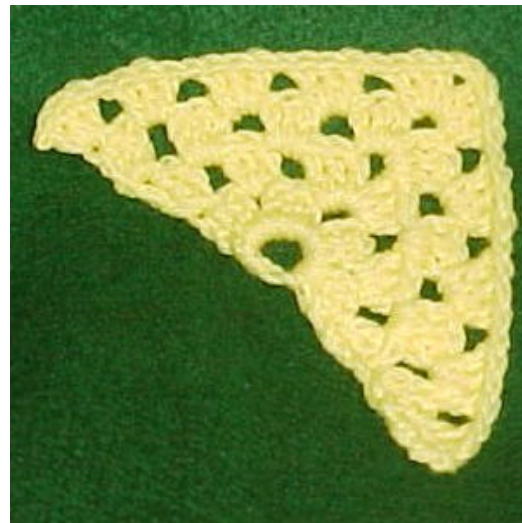
Worsted weight acrylic yarn in any color  
Size H/8 or 5mm aluminum crochet hook  
Yarn needle for weaving in ends

**Yarn Thickness:** 4mm

**Gauge:** 4dc = 1"

**Finished Size:** 5" x 5" x 6"

**Skill Level:** Beginner



## Instructions

**ROW 1:** Ch8. Join w/slst to first ch to form ring. Ch3. 2dc in ring. Ch1. 3dc, ch3, 2dc in ring. Ch1. 3dc in ring. Ch3, turn.

**ROW 2:** 2dc in first dc. Ch1. 3dc in next ch1 sp. Ch1. 3dc, ch2, 3dc in next ch2 sp. Ch1. 3dc in next ch1

sp. Ch1. 3dc in top of ch3. Ch3, turn.

**ROW 3:** 2dc in first dc. Ch1. 3dc in next ch1 sp, Ch1, twice. 3dc, ch2, 3dc in next ch2 sp. Ch1. 3dc in next ch1 sp, ch1 twice. 3dc in top of ch3. Ch3, turn.

**ROW 4:** 2dc in first dc. Ch1. 3dc in next ch1 sp, ch1, 3 times. 3dc, ch2, 3dc in next ch2 sp. Ch1. 3dc in next ch1 sp, ch1, 3 times. 3dc in top of ch3. Ch1 and fasten off. Weave ends into back of work.
