# Scallop E dged Placemat 

Designed by Julie A. Bolduc

This placemat is started with a strip which is then crocheted around and then is finished off with a round of scallops in a pretty contrasting color. It would make a great addition to any dining table and the colors can be changed for any season.

## Materials Needed

Worsted weight cotton yarn. Peaches \& Creme, in 2 colors, was used in the example.*
Size G/6 or 4 mm aluminum crochet hook
Yarn needle for weaving in ends.
Yarn Thickness: 3mm
Gauge: 5dc=1"
Finished Size: 18" x 13½"
Skill Level: Beginner to Intermediate

## Instructions

Starting Strip: With main color, ch8, join w/slst to first ch to form ring. Ch4. Tr in same st as slst. Ch4, tr in top of previous tr , twice. Ch 8 , slst in top of previous tr.

RND 1: Treat each tr as a ch4 sp on this round. Slst into the next ch4 sp. Ch 3 , 3dc in same sp. Ch1, 4dc in next ch4 sp, twice. Ch1. 4dc, ch1, 4dc, ch1, 4 dc in next ch8 lp. Ch1, 4dc in next ch4 sp, 3 times. Ch1, 4dc, ch1, 4dc, ch1, 4dc in next ch8 lp. Ch1. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 2: Ch1. Sc in each of the next 3 dc. Sc in next ch1 sp, sc in each of the next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 3$ times. (Sc in next ch1 corner sp . Sc in each of the next 4 dc . 3 sc in next ch1 corner sp.) sc in each of the next 4 dc , sc in next ch1 sp, 4 times. Sc in each of the next 4 dc . Rep bet () once. Sc in each of the next 4 dc. Sc in next ch1 sp. Join w/slst to ch1.

RND 3: Ch5. Sk 2 sc . Dc in each of the next 3 sc, ch2, sk 2 sc, 3 times. (Dc in next sc. 2dc in next sc. Ch2. Sk next sc. 2dc in next sc. Dc in next sc.

Ch2. Sk 2 sc. Dc in next sc. 2dc in next sc. Join w/slst to 3rd ch of ch5.

RND 4: Ch1. 2sc in next ch2 sp. Sc in each of the next $3 \mathrm{dc}, 4$ times. ( 3 sc in next ch2 sp, sc in each of the next 3 dc. 2 sc in next ch2 sp. Sc in each of the next 3 dc. 3 sc in next ch 2 sp .) Sc in each of the next $3 \mathrm{~d}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next ch2 sp, 5 times. Sc in each of the next 3 dc. Rep bet () once. Sc in each of the next 3 dc. 2 sc in next ch2 sp. Sc in each of the last 2 dc . Join w/slst to ch1.

RND 5: Ch3. Dc in each of the next 3 sc. Sk next sc. Dc in each of the next 4 sc , ch1, sk $1 \mathrm{sc}, 3$ times. (Dc in each of the next 2 sc .2 dc , ch2, 2dc in next sc . Dc in each of the next 2 sc . Ch1. Sk next sc. Dc in each of the next 4 sc. Ch1. Sk next sc. Dc in each of the next 2 sc. 2dc, ch2, 2dc in next sc. Dc in each of the next 2 sc. ) Ch1, sk next sc , dc in each of the next 4 sc , 5 times. Ch1. Sk next sc. Rep bet () once. Ch1. Sk next sc. Dc in each of the next 4 sc. Ch1. Sk next sc. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 6: Ch1. Sc in each of the next 3 dc. Sc in next ch1 sp, sc in each of the
next 4 dc, 4 times. (3sc in next ch2 sp. Sc in each of the next 4 dc , sc in next ch1 sp, twice. Sc in each of the next 4 dc. 3 sc in next ch2 sp.) Sc in each of the next 4 dc , sc in next ch2 sp, 6 times. Sc in each of the next 4 dc . Rep bet () once. Sc in each of the next 4 dc, sc in next ch1 sp, twice. Join w/slst to ch1.

RND 7: Ch5. Sk 2 sc. Dc in each of the next 3 sc , ch2, sk $2 \mathrm{dc}, 4$ times. (Dc in next sc. 2 dc in next sc. Ch2. Sk next sc. 2dc in next sc. Dc in next sc. Ch2, sk 2 sc, dc in each of the next 3sc, twice. Ch2. Sk 2sc. Dc in next sc. 2 dc in next sc. Ch2. Sk next sc. 2dc in next sc. Dc in next sc.) Ch2, sk 2 sc, dc in each of the next 3 sc , 6 times. Ch2. Sk 2 sc . Dc in each of the next 2 sc. Ch2. Sk 2 sc . Dc in each of the last 2 sc. Join w/slst to top 3rd ch of ch5.

RND 8: Ch1. Sc in next ch1 sp, sc in each of the next $3 \mathrm{dc}, 5$ times. (3sc in next ch2 sp. Sc in each of the next 3dc, sc in next ch1 sp, 3 times. Sc in each of the next 3dc. 3sc in next ch2 sp .) Sc in each of the next 3 dc , sc in next ch1 sp, 7 times. Sc in each of the next 3dc. Rep bet () once. Sc in each of the next 3 dc , sc in next ch1 sp,
twice. Sc in each of the last 2 dc . Join w/slst to ch1.

RND 9: Ch3. Dc in each of the next 3 sc . Ch1, sk next sc, dc in each of the next 4 sc, 4 times. (Ch1. Sk next sc. Dc in each of the next 2 sc . 2 dc , ch2, 2dc in next sc. Dc in each of the next 2 sc, ch1, sk next sc, dc in each of the next 4 sc, 3 times. Ch1. Sk next sc. Dc in each of the next 2 sc . 2 dc , ch2, 2dc in next sc. Dc in each of the next 2 sc.) Ch1, sk next sc, dc in each of the next 4 sc, 7 times. Rep bet () once. Ch1, sk next sc, dc in each of the next 4 sc , twice. Ch1. Sk next sc. Join w/slst top of ch3.

RND 10: Ch1. Sc in each of the next 3dc. Sc in next ch1 sp, sc in each of the next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 5$ times. ( 3 sc in next ch2 sp . Sc in each of the next 4 dc , sc in next ch1 sp, 4 times. Sc in each of the next 4 dc. 3 sc in next ch 2 sp .) Sc in each of the next 4 dc , sc in next ch1 sp, 8 times. Sc in each of the next 4 dc. Rep bet () once. sc in each of the next 4 dc , sc in next ch1 sp, 3 times. Join w/slst to ch1.

RND 11: Ch5. Sk 2 sc . Dc in each of the next 3 sc , ch2, sk $2 \mathrm{sc}, 5$ times. (Dc in each of the next 2 sc .2 dc , ch2, 2dc in next sc. Dc in each of the next 2 sc . Ch2, sk 2 sc , dc in each of the next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 4$ times. Ch2. Sk 2 sc . Dc in each of the next $2 \mathrm{sc} .2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2$, 2 dc in next sc . Dc in each of the next 2 dc .) Ch2, sk 2 sc, dc in each of the next 3 $\mathrm{sc}, 8$ times. Ch2. sk 2 sc . Rep bet () once. Ch2, sk 2 sc , dc in each of the
next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ times. Ch2, sk 2 sc . Dc in each of the last 2 sc . Join w/slst to 3rd ch of ch5.

RND 12: Ch1. 2sc in next ch 2 sp , sc in each of the next $3 \mathrm{dc}, 5$ times. 2 sc in next ch1 sp . (Sc in each of the next 4 dc .3 sc in next ch 2 corner sp . Sc in each of the next 4 dc .2 sc in next ch2 sp , sc in each of the next $3 \mathrm{dc}, 4$ times. 2 sc in next ch 2 sp . Sc in each of the next 4 dc . 3 sc in next ch 2 corner sp. Sc in each of the next 4 dc .) 2 sc in next ch 2 sp , sc in each of the next 3 dc, 8 times. 2 sc in next ch2 sp. Rep bet () once. 2 sc in next ch2 sp, sc in each of the next 3 dc , twice. 2 sc in next ch 2 sp . Sc in each of the last 2 dc . Join w/slst to ch1.

RND 13: Ch3. dcin each of the next 3 sc, ch1, sk 1 sc , dc in each of the next 4 sc, 5 times. Ch1. Sk 1 sc. (Dc in each of the next 3 sc . Dc, ch 2 , dc in next ch2 sp. Dc in each of the next 3 sc. Ch1, sk next sc, dc in each of the next 4 sc, 5 times. Ch1. Sk next sc, dc in each of the next 3 sc . Dc, ch2, dc in next sc. dc in each of the next 3 sc .) Ch1, sk next sc, dc in each of the next 4 sc, 9 times. Ch1. Sk 1 sc. Rep bet () once. Ch1. Sk next sc. Dc in each of the next 4 sc, ch1, sk next sc, 3 times. Join w/slst to topo of ch3.

RND 14: Ch1. Sc in each of the next 3 dc . Sc in next ch1 sp, sc in each of the next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 6$ times. (3sc in next ch2 sp . Sc in each of the next 4 dc , sc in next ch1 sp, 6 times. Sc in each of the next 4 dc. 3 sc in next ch2 sp.) Sc in
each of the next 4 dc , sc in next ch1 sp, 10 times. Sc in each of the next 4 dc. Rep bet () once. Sc in each of the next 4 dc , sc in next ch1 sp, 4 times. Join w/slst to ch1.

RND 15: Ch5. Sk 2 sc . Dc in each of the next 3 sc, ch2, sk 2 sc, 6 times. (Dc in each of the next 2 sc . Dc, ch2, dc in next sc. Dc in each of the next 2 sc. Ch2. Sk 2 sc . Sc in each of the next $3 \mathrm{dc}, 6$ times. Ch2. Sk2 sc. Dc in each of the next 2 dc . Dc, ch2, dc in next sc. Dc in each of the next 2 dc .) Ch2, sk 2 sc, dc in each of the next 3 sc, 10 times. Ch2. Sk 2 sc . Rep bet () once. Ch2, sk $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dc}$ in each of the next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 3$ times. Ch2. Sk 2 sc . Dc in each of the last 2 sc. Join w/slst to 3rd ch of ch5.

RND 16: Join color 2 to next ch 2 sp after joining last round. Ch3, 6dc in same sp. Sk next dc. Sc in next dc. *7dc in next ch2 sp. Sk next dc. Sc in next dc. Rep from * around. Join $w /$ slst to top of ch3. Fasten off and weave ends into back of work.
> *I used a cone of Peaches \& Creme of each color but for the contrasting final round, you can use one ball. The variegated yarn is Sunrise and the other yarn is Ecru! I think you could get 3 placemat, last rounds from one ball. And probably 3 or 4 placemats from one cone of the main color.
