



Eyeglass Caddy

This eyeglass caddy is a fast and easy pattern to make and is just the right size to keep a pair of glasses safe at night on your night stand!

Materials Needed

Red Heart Plush Yarn color#9103 cream
Worsted weight acrylic yarn in shaded blues.
Size H/8 or 5mm aluminum crochet hook
Empty Crystal Light Container
Yarn needle for weaving in ends

Yarn Thickness: 4mm

Gauge: 4dc = 1"

Finished Size: 2½" x 5¼"

Skill Level: Beginner

Instructions

RND 1: With plush yarn. Ch 5. Join w/slst to first ch to form ring. Ch3. 14 dc in ring. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 2: Ch3. Dc in same st as slst. 2dc in each dc around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 3-11: Ch3. Dc in each dc around. Join w/slst to top of ch3. Fasten off plush.

RND 12: Join shaded blues in same st as slst. Ch1. Sc in each dc around. Join w/slst to first sc. You should now have 29 sc around.

RND 13: Ch3. Dc in each sc around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 14: Ch1. Sc in each st around. Join w/slst to ch1.

RND 15-22: Rep rounds 13 & 14 consecutively. Fasten off and weave ends into back of work.



Finishing Assembly: Tuck crochet piece into container and pull extra to the outside. This is removable so you can throw it in the wash when it gets dusty.

Finishing Tip: I used a remote control to push the bottom of the crochet piece into the bottom of the container.
