

Trapezoid Potholder

This potholder was fun to make and it can be completed in an evening. It is a good pattern to make when you don't feel like concentrating on a pattern's instructions to closely.

Materials Needed

Worsted weight cotton yarn in Denim Grey Worsted weight cotton yarn in ombre pastels Size H/8 aluminum crochet hook Yarn needle for weaving in ends

Yarn Thickness: 4mm Gauge: 4dc = 1" Finished Size: 9"wx7"h Skill Level: Beginner



Instructions ROW 1: With grey, ch 21. Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch3, turn.

ROW 2: Dc in first sc (so that you have 2 dc in first sc.) and in each sc across. Work a total of 2 dc in last sc. Ch1, turn.

ROW 3: Sc in each dc across. Sc in
top of ch3. Ch3, turn.across the top and bottom and work
2 sc in each of the 4 corners. Join

ROW 4-17: Rep rows 2 & 3 started stitching them together. consecutively. Fasten off and weave ends into back of work. Make another one with the ombre pastels and do not fasten off the 2nd piece.



Finishing Assembly: Place both pieces together, wrong sides facing each other. Use a sc through both layers. Work 1 sc in each sc row, 2sc in each dc row, 1sc in each st across the top and bottom and work 2 sc in each of the 4 corners. Join w/slst to the first sc where you started stitching them together. Fasten off. Weave ell ends into work.
