



# Refillable Sachet

This sachet is made into a pouch which has a drawstring ribbon top so you can refill this sachet as you need to.

## Materials Needed

Size 10 crochet cotton in color of choice. Southmaid amethyst was used in the example.

Size 7 steel crochet hook

Scented potpourri of choice

2 double faced satin ribbons, white and yellow. ¼" x 12"

**Yarn Thickness:** 10thread

**Gauge:** 10sc = 1"

**Finished Size:** 3" x 3"

**Skill Level:** Beginner



## Instructions

**RND 1:** Ch8. Join w/slst to first ch to form ring. Ch4. Dc in ring, ch1, 11 times. Join w/slst to 3rd ch of ch4.

**RND 2:** Ch3. (2dc in next ch1 sp. Dc in next dc. Ch4.) \*Dc in next dc. Rep bet () once. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

**RND 3:** Ch5. (Sk 2dc. Dc in next dc. Ch1. Dc in next ch, ch1. Dc in next ch. Ch3. Dc in next ch, ch1, twice.) \*Dc in next dc. Ch2. Rep bet () once. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to 3rd ch of ch5.

**RND 4-16:** Ch5. (Dc in next dc, ch1, twice. Dc in next dc. Ch3. Dc in next dc, ch1, twice.) \*Dc in next dc, ch2. Rep bet () once. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to 3rd ch of ch5.

**RND 17:** Ch1. (2sc in next ch2 sp. Sc in next dc, sc in next ch1 sp, twice. Sc in next dc. 2dc, ch2, 2dc in next ch3 sp. Sc in next dc, sc in next ch1 sp, twice.) \*Sc in next dc. Rep bet () once. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to ch1. Fasten off and weave ends into back of work. Weave ribbons through round 15, stuff with potpourri then draw up and tie into a bow.

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
