



Fiesta Scrunchie

This very full scrunchie is perfect for adding just the right touch to a bright and cheerful summer outfit. It would look great with a pair of jeans and a white shirt. It works up quickly and you could make several in an evening.

Materials Needed:

Small amount worsted weight yarn.
Red Heart Mexicana was used in the example.
Size H/8 or 5mm aluminum crochet hook
One large pony tail holder elastic

Yarn Thickness: 4mm

Gauge: 4dc = 1"

Finished Size: =4" diameter

Skill Level: Easy

Instructions

Tie yarn onto elastic.

RND 1: Ch5, yo, insert hook in 3rd ch from hook, draw up a loop, yo draw through 2 lps on hook, yo, insert hook in same ch, draw up a lp, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook, yo, draw through all 3 lps on hook. Ch3, sc in elastic. Rep RND 1 all the way around until the elastic is as full as you want it. I repeated a total of 35 times. Fasten off and weave ends into work, working away from the elastic to the outside.



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
