

Braid Stitch Scrunchie

This scrunchie uses the special stitch the braid stitch. It is fast and fun to make and you could make several in an evening.

Materials Needed:

Small amount Red Heart worsted weight yarn in Red. large hair elastic Size H/8 or 5mm aluminum or wood crochet hook

Gauge: 4dc=1" Yarn Thickness: 4mm Finished Size: 5"diameter Skill Level: Beginner

Braid Stitch (brd)

To do this stitch just insert your hook in the stitch indicated, draw up a loop, and while keeping the first loop on your hook, ch3 then yo and pull through both loops on hook.

Instructions

RND 1: Tie yarn onto elastic. Work 30 sc in elastic ring. Join w/slst to first sc.

RND 2: Ch3. Brd in next sc. *Dc in next sc. Brd in next sc. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch3. **RND 3:** You will be working in the spaces between the stitches on this rnd. Slst into the first sp. Sc in same sp. *Ch4, slst in 3rd ch from hook. Ch1. Sc in next 2 sps. Rep from * around ending with a w/s/st to first sc to join. Fasten off and weave ends into work.

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
