

Flower Scrunchie

This is a fast and easy scrunchie that would look great done in a wide variety of colors. You could make several in an evening!

## **Materials Needed**

Small amount worsted weight acrylic yarn. Excellence by Nomis was used in the exampleColor: Copen #304.1 large hair elasticSize H/8 or 5mm aluminum crochet hook



Yarn Thickness 3mm Gauge 5sc=1" Finished Size: 5" diam Skill Level: Beginner

## Instructions

**RND 1:** Tie yarn onto elastic. Treat elastic as a ring. \*3sc in ring. Ch7. Rep from \* 9 times more. You should now have 10 ch7lps around. You can add more if you want a fuller scrunchie. **RND 2:** Slst to the next sc. Ch3. Sk next sc. (Dc, ch1, dc, ch1, dc, ch3, dc, ch1, dc, ch1, dc. in next ch7 lp.) Sk next sc. \*Dc in next sc. Sk next sc. Rep bet () once. Sk next sc. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to top of ch3. Fasten off and weave ends into back of work.

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
