Scalloped Trebles Scrunchie

This scrunchie is fast and easy to make and several can be completed in an evening. It has a round of trebles followed by a round of shells. Very simple. It would make a quick and great bazaar item.

Materials Needed

Small amount worsted weight acrylic yarn of desired color. Large hair elastic Size G aluminum crochet hook Tapestry Needle for weaving in ends

Yarn Thickness: 4mm

Gauge: 4sc=1"

Finished Size: 5" diameter Skill Level: Beginner

Instructions

RND 1: Tie yarn onto elastic band. Treat band as a starter ring. Ch5. *Tr in band. Ch1. Rep from * until you have 28 tr around. Join w/slst to 4th ch of ch5.

RND 2: Slst into the first ch1 sp. Ch1. 5dc in next ch1 sp. *Sc in next ch1 sp. 5dc in next ch1



sp. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to ch1. Fasten off, weave ends into back of work.

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
