



Frosted Scrunchie

This pretty scrunchie is fast and easy to make and would look great with any color combination you can think of.

Materials Needed

Worsted weight acrylic yarn in Baby Sport Pompadour in White
Worsted weight acrylic yarn in bright pink
Size H/8 aluminum crochet hook
Yarn needle for weaving in ends
1 large hair elastic

Yarn Thickness: 4mm

Gauge: 4dc = 1"

Finished Size: 5" diam

Skill Level: Beginner

Instructions

RND 1: With pink. Tie onto elastic band. Ch10. Slst in 7th ch from hook. Ch1. *Sc in elastic. Ch9. Slst in 7th ch from hook. Rep from *

22 times more. Join w/slst to first ch of ch10. Fasten off pink.

RND 2: Join white in any of the ch7 lps. Work 9 sc in each ch7 lp

around. Join w/slst to first sc in first lp. Fasten off. Weave all ends into back of work.
