



# Citrus Stitch Scrunchie

This scrunchie is made with a stitch I developed a few years ago. [The Citrus Stitch](#). It works up fast so you could make several in different colors for a gift for someone!

## Materials Needed

Worsted weight acrylic yarn in red.  
Size H/8 aluminum crochet hook  
Large hair elastic  
Metal Yarn needle for weaving in ends

**Yarn Thickness:** 4mm

**Gauge:** 4dc = 1"

**Finished Size:** 4" diam

**Skill Level:** Beginner

## Instructions

### [Special Stitch Citrus Stitch \(cit\):](#)

Ch5, insert hook in 2nd ch from hook, pull up a lp, \*insert hook in next st and pull up a lp. Rep from \* 2 more times. Yo and pull through all 5 lps on hook. Ch1 to close.

**RND 1:** Tie yarn onto hair elastic. Ch8, insert hook in 2nd ch from hook, pull up a lp, \*insert hook in next st and pull up a lp. Rep from \* 2 more times. Yo and pull through all 5 lps on hook. Ch1 to close. You will have 3 chs left, which count as

a dc. \*Dc in elastic, cit. Rep from \* 23 times more or until the elastic is full. Join w/slst to 3rd ch of ch8. Fasten off and weave ends into back of work.



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
