



# Side Stitches Scrunchie

This scrunchie is made in a way where a chain is worked then each chain has dc's worked on each one. It is fast and easy to make and would make a great addition to anyone's scrunchie wardrobe.

## Materials Needed

Worsted weight acrylic yarn in any color you want.

Size H/8 or 5mm aluminum crochet hook

Large hair elastic

Yarn needle for weaving in ends

**Yarn Thickness:** 4mm

**Gauge:** 4dc = 1"

**Finished Size:** 5" diam

**Skill Level:** Beginner



## Instructions

**RND 1:** Join yarn onto elastic. \*Sc in elastic. Ch6. Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each of the next 2 chs. Dc in elastic. Ch2. Rep from \* until the elastic is full about 13 times. You can add more or less if needed. Join w/slt to first sc. Fasten off and weave ends into back of work.

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
