

Tri Bead & Pony Scrunchie

This scrunchie is fast and easy to make and would look great made with any combination of beads you could imagine.

Materials Needed

Worsted weight acrylic yarn in desired color 28 regular pony beads, assorted colors 56 tri beads assorted colors and sizes with a hole big enough for a large eye needle to go through Large hair elastic Size H/8 or 5mm aluminum crochet hook Yarn needle for weaving in ends

Yarn Thickness: 4mm

Gauge: 4dc = 1"

Finished Size: 5" diam Skill Level: Beginner



Instructions

STEP 1: Put end of yarn through needle then string on all beads onto yarn in the following order. Make groups of tri bead, pony bead, tri bead. So you will end up with 2 tri beads in a row.

STEP: Join yarn to elastic and treat ch as dc. Rep from * until you use the elastic as if it were a starting ring. Ch7. Pull up one group of 3 beads. Dc in 4th ch from hook. Ch3. ends into work. Slst in same ch as dc. *Dc in elastic ring. Ch3. Bring up 3 beads. Dc in 3rd ch from hook. Ch3. Slst in same

up all of the beads. Join w/slst to 3rd ch of ch7. Fasten off and weave

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
