



Thermal Stitch Scarf

This pattern is meant to go with the Thermal Stitch Hat. It is fairly easy to make but time consuming. It is well worth the effort and is a scarf pattern you can make as long as you want.

Materials Needed

8-9oz Worsted Weight acrylic yarn in Cherry Red
Size I9/5.5mm crochet hook
Yarn needle for weaving in ends

Yarn Thickness: 4mm

Gauge: 4dc = 1inch

Finished Size: 6inch by 36inches long

Skill Level: Beginner

Special Stitch:

Single Crochet front back bobble: (scfbb) Insert hook in back lp only of next st. yo, draw up a loop. You will now have 2 lps on hook. Yo, draw through one lp on hook. Now, insert hook in front lp of same stitch from the inside toward you, yo draw up a lp. You should now have 3 lps on hook. Yo and pull through all 3 lps on hook.

Instructions

ROW 1: Ch26, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 3, turn.

ROW 2: Sk first sc. Dc in each of the next 24 sc. Ch1, turn

ROW 3: Sc in each dc across and in top of ch3. Ch2, turn.

ROW 4: Sk first sc. *Scfbb in next sc. Hdc in next sc. Rep from * across. Ch1, turn

ROW 5: Sc in each st across and in top of ch2. Ch3, turn.

ROW 6-181: Rep rows 2-6 consecutively until it is the length you want it to be.

ROW 182 or next row: Rep Row 2.

ROW 183 or last row: Sc in each st across and in top of ch2. Fasten off and weave ends into back of work.
